# SUPPORT HANDWASHING



## FEATURE OVERVIEW

The intent of this feature is to **ensure support of hygienic hand washing practices for all individuals.**

Sinks, soap containers, and hand drying towels can all harbor and spread harmful bacteria even after use; therefore, handwashing is not always enough. It is critical that bathrooms and other handwashing stations are designed and furnished to ease proper hygiene.

## HIGHLIGHTS OF WHAT WE'VE DONE



### HANDS-FREE SOAP DISPENSERS

Soap dispensers are sensor activated and include sealed, disposable cartridges to prevent bacterial growth and limit surface contact for users.



### COMPOSTABLE PAPER TOWELS

Reusable hand towels that can spread bacteria from one user to the next have been replaced with compostable paper towels at each hand washing station.



### TOUCH-FREE FAUCETS

Every bathroom is equipped with motion activated faucets to reduce surface contact



### VISUAL CUES

Signage directs individuals to the nearest handwashing station and how-to guides are installed and visible to encourage and support proper handwashing.

## BENEFITS

Provides the tools and resources in order to ease proper hygiene, and visual cues improve compliance with established guidelines.

Handwashing stations in The Alliance Center can be used frequently while still preventing bacterial spread and reducing the shared surface contacts between occupants.
