

# BOLSTER EMERGENCY RESILIENCE



## FEATURE OVERVIEW

The intent of this feature is to enable individuals and communities to maintain health and well-being and organizations to maintain business function, during and after emergencies.

A wide variety of emergencies, from biological events, winter storms and tornadoes to active shooters or terrorist attacks, may necessitate sheltering in place. Infectious disease pandemics can cause extended business shutdowns, while employees who continue working may be forced to work in high-risk conditions or in remote spaces not equipped to support productivity. Finally, studies show the capacity of hospital facilities decreases significantly in the aftermath of natural disasters, potentially forcing them to ration resources and outsource healthcare workers.
